**The Organising Authority is the Porthpean eSailing Club (PeSC) and the Scorpion Class Association**

### Combined Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions

#### 1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Virtual Racing Rules of Sailing* dated 22nd January 2019
- 1.2 Rule infringements will be decided by the VR system and its decisions are final and are not appealable, so there!

#### 2. ENTRY

Entry is open to all Scorpion Sailors. Entry is free.

#### 3. SCHEDULE OF RACES

There will be two practice races and six series races held on 25th May 2020 between the hours of 10:00am and midday. The plan is to start a race every 10 minutes, but this may change if delays are needed.

#### 5. EQUIPMENT

The equipment to be 'sailed' will be the 'J70' class.

#### 6. COURSE

The course will be "Upwind Medium" – a windward / leeward course with an offset mark and a downwind finish. TWO laps. The race target time will be 6 minutes and 52 seconds. See diagram below.

#### 7. SCORING

- 7.1 The Low Points Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply.
- 7.2 TWO discards can be taken in the six races.
- 7.4 Ties will be broken in accordance with RRS A8.
- 7.5 RRS A4.2 is changed such that a boat that did not start, did not finish, retired or was disqualified shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats entered in the largest group.

#### 8. STARTING RACES

Races shall be started by using the following signals.

Minutes before starting signal	Visual signal	Sound signal	Means
1:15	P and Virtual Regatta flag	One	Warning signal
1:00	P removed	One	Preparatory signal
0:00	Virtual Regatta flag removed	One	Starting signal

## 9. PRIZES

The first three competitors (and everyone else) may award themselves a beverage of their own choice from their drinks cabinet / fridge.
